Sept. 10: What does it mean to accept a friend?

In Romans 15:7, Paul writes, Christ has accepted you. So accept one another in order to bring praise to God, (NIV). We see this played out perfectly through Paul and Barnabus.

Sept. 17: When a friend hurts you, how do you respond?

In Colossians 3:13, Paul writes, Put up with one another. Forgive one another if you are holding something against someone. Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you, (NIV). Towards the end of the book of John we see this through Jesus and Peter.

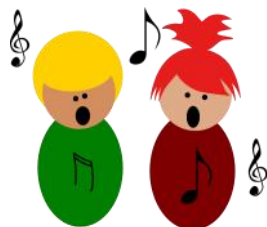
