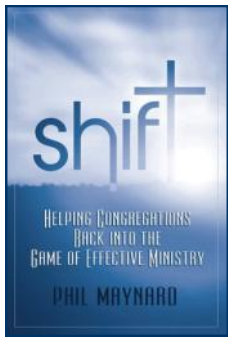

Medicare card is required and the vaccination is free. Everyone else will need to bring their insurance card or \$37 cash or check. Persons under 65 will receive the quadrivalent dose. Walgreens on Red Rock Ln. will be managing this clinic. There will be a pharmacist giving the shots. We need at least 25 persons coming to this clinic. Please sign up or call Marsha Dunn 402-484-6407. This will save you a cost of a Doctor visit and a great place to keep yourself and others safe from the epidemic of the flu!!

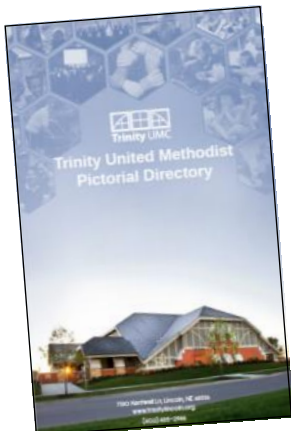

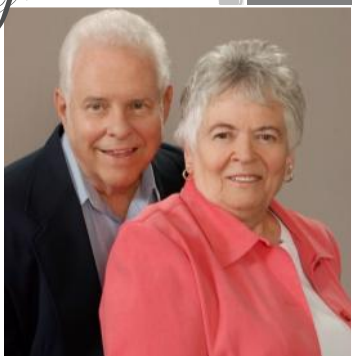

## Epworth Village Update

For any of you who have wondered about the current status of Epworth Village I have good news to share!

In April of 2017 Epworth Village announced the end of residential treatment at the campus in York. Programs transitioned to in-home family services and foster care programs that provide preventative support and tools to families in need of healing. This has resulted in an increase in the number of families served from 22 families in October 2016 to 38 families in May 2017 and now to 82 families in June 2018.

In addition Epworth Village has opened a day care program in York, named "Little Jewels", named with recognition of the original name of Mothers' Jewels Home. This fills a real need in the community.

Epworth Village continues to need donated in-kind items. A list of their current needs is available at the church (office or lobby) As always, financial donations are very welcome!

**We're Packing/Delivering food for Ruth Hill Elementary during the school year and we need your help!**

School is back in session and the **Food Bank of Lincoln Backpack Program** will begin the end of August. Trinity's partnership with Hill elementary school provides food each week for 26 students to take home for the weekend.

In addition to packing the individual bags after the service each Sunday there are two more ways to be involved. Each Sunday morning the food needs to be brought from the storage cabinets in the youth room upstairs and set up on tables in Spirit Hall for packing. The bags are placed in totes to be returned to the storage cabinets awaiting delivery to the school.

Each week the totes are delivered to the school, with only a few exceptions as noted in the sign up date, no later than Thursday afternoon at 4:00 pm.

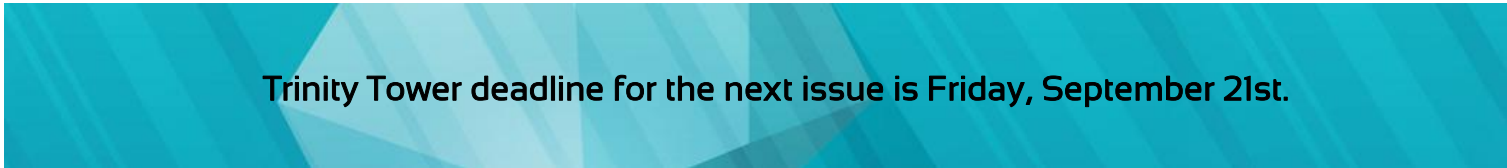
